- Targeted class children – 2<sup>nd</sup> Std to 5<sup>th</sup> Std
- No. Of Children Benifitted last year – 994 (488 Boys & 506 girls)

# CHILD RIGHTS

## 1. Talent Quest Competition:

- Scale of Coverage – 4 clusters
- No. Of Children participated in the competition – 216
- Cluster level competition – Speech & Fancy dress
- Inter cluster level competition – Dance & Photography
- Prize distribution event on – 27.08.2017
- Past beneficiaries were invited as chief guests, their testimony inspired all the children.
- Total children participated in this event – 347.

## 2. Annual Sports Event:

- Scale of Coverage – 4 cluster
- No. Of Children sangam children participated – 53
- Sport meet organized by – Concern India at Guindy Nehru Park
- Sports conducted were – Long jump, High Jump, Running race, Relay, Shot put.
- All of our 53 children received medals and certificates
- Overall trophy (2 bicycles) won by our Sangam children – S. Mukesh & S. Preethi

## **3. International Child Rights Day Event:**

- We organised a big event on Child Rights day - On 20/11/17
- Location - At opposite locality to Dr. Ambedkar college
- No. Of participants gathered - 382
- Chief guests were P5 Women Inspector Mrs. Chitra and Mr. Paramasivam (Joint Secretary-BSAC).
- Our children sangam children performed cultural events (Parai Aatam, Oyil Aatam and street theatre) on Child abuse and child protection.
- On the same day we released a poster with 20 types of Child abuse.
- Those Child abuse posters were pasted in the place where public will gather by our Children sangam children.

## **4. Enrolling Dropouts:**

- Scale of Coverage – 16 Areas
- No. Of Drop outs finding – 14
- No. Of Drop outs benefitted by enrolled in schools – 7
- Frequent follow up plus enrolled them in our Children sangam as well supplementary education center.

- Our children sangam children were performed special programmes were Parai Aatam and Oyil Aatam.
- Also a special performance given by the AMC cultural team, they have performed Parai, Oyil, Kazhiyal, Garagam, Maadu viratu, Poi kaal guthirai, Silambam, water cup silambam and Blowing fire dance.
- At the end of the event we gifted a pack of Sweet Pongal and a piece of sugarcane to all of them.
