-  Tailoring Training – More than 90 women successfully trained
-  Beautician Course – Around 75 women completed training
-  Aari Work Training – Over 60 women gained specialized embroidery skills

The program has empowered women with income-generating skills, self-confidence, and opportunities for independent livelihoods. Many participants have started small businesses, home-based services, and freelance work in their communities.
